The Highland Heights Day Camp Program is designed to provide a safe, fun, non-competitive, recreational experience for children entering kindergarten through 7th grade in the fall of 2019.

The camp is located at the Highland Hts. Community Park in the Park Barn Pavilion, located across the drive from the pool. This location provides plenty of outdoor space for activities as well as a large indoor facility in the event of inclement weather.

Day Camp Sessions

Day Camp Sessions begin at 9:00 a.m. and end at 4:00 p.m. Camp sessions begin on Monday, June 3 with the last day of camp on Friday, July 26.

Campers may attend any number of weekly sessions. A multi-week discount is built into the camp fees. **However, please be advised that any additional weeks added after Day Camp begins are charged at the weekly rate of \$155 per week for Highland Hts. residents and \$210 per week for non-residents.** Campers must register and pay in full for all sessions they will attend. You can pick and choose which weeks you would like your child to attend day camp. Weeks need not be consecutive.

General Camp Information

Rain Days: Day Camp operates rain or shine with activities taking place within the shelter of the Park Barn Pavilion during inclement weather.

Field Trips: Field trips are an integral part of the camp program. Separate field trip permission slips are not distributed prior to each trip. However, field trip information will be made available by our Camp Director on a weekly basis. If you do not want your child to participate in any or all field trips, please notify the Camp Director prior to the trip.

Lunch: Campers need to bring their own snacks and lunch with the camper's name clearly marked on the lunch bag or container. Please note that refrigeration is not available.

Clothing: **One** Highland Heights Day Camp t-shirt will be provided to each camper. No additional t-shirts will be given. All campers must wear their t-shirt on field trip days. Please mark all items with your child's name. A bathing suit, towel and sunscreen should be brought to camp each day. For safety, campers should wear tennis shoes to camp everyday.

Special Requests: If your child has special health or religious concerns requiring attention, please make sure to note it on the registration form. When we develop camp groups, we must take many factors into consideration in the best interest of all the children.

Child Drop-off and Pick-up: Drop-off and pick-up will take place at the Park Barn Pavilion. You will be asked to fill out a pick-up list for each child attending camp.

Program Escorts: Each camper that is enrolled in Tennis or Swim Lessons during camp sessions will be escorted by a counselor or a camp volunteer to and from their program lesson. **Campers enrolled in swim lessons, level 1-4, must attend lessons before 10:30 a.m. Please let the Day Camp Coordinator know the times of your children's lessons.**

Before and After Care: This program runs before and after camp from 7:00 a.m. until 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m. The cost is \$4.00 per half hour and \$7.00 per hour to be paid directly, in cash, to the caregiver at the time of drop off or pick up. Any child not picked up by 4:05 p.m. will be placed in after care. Before and after care is a service we provide separate from camp and must be paid in cash directly to the worker present.
