A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE AMOUNTS AND RATES AS DETERMINED BY THE BUDGET COMMISSION AND AUTHORIZING THE NECESSARY TAX LEVIES TO BE PLACED ON THE 2017 TAX DUPLICATE OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, OHIO AND CERTIFYING THE SAME TO THE COUNTY FISCAL OFFICER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Highland Heights has adopted a Tax Budget for the fiscal year commencing January 1, 2018, in the manner provided by law; and

WHEREAS, the Budget Commission of Cuyahoga County has certified its action approving said Budget to this Council, together with an estimate of the rate of each tax necessary to be levied by this Council, and what part thereof is without, and what part within the ten-mill limitation; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, OHIO, THAT:

Section 1 The estimated tax rates for the tax year 2017 as determined by the Cuyahoga County Budget Commission, be and the same are hereby approved and accepted.

Section 2 Pursuant to Section 5705.34 of the Ohio Revised Code, levy of general property taxes be and is hereby authorized, to be placed on the 2017 tax duplicate of the City of Highland Heights, at the following rates, within and without the ten-mill limitation.

Section 3. The Clerk of this Council be and is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the County Fiscal Officer of Cuyahoga County in satisfaction of the Requirements of Section 5604.34 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code. .

Section 5 This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Highland Heights for the further reason that it provides for essential governmental services. It shall therefore take place immediately upon passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approval by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.




