A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY GENERAL HEALTH DISTRICT FOR THE PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICES TO BE RENDERED DURING THE YEAR 2018, TO DIRECT THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY AUDITOR TO CREDIT THE CONSIDERATION PAYABLE UNDER SAID CONTRACT TO THE DISTRICT HEALTH FUND OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY, AND TO DEDUCT EQUIVALENT SUMS FROM TAX SETTLEMENTS DUE THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County General Health District performs essential health services for all communities of Cuyahoga County, including the City of Highland Heights, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the cost of such services is paid by all participating subdivisions on a per capita basis, based on current population estimates; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, OHIO, THAT:

Section 1 The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract for public health services with the Cuyahoga County General Health District for the calendar year 2018, a copy of said contract being attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A", and incorporated herein as if fully rewritten.


Section 2 The Auditor of Cuyahoga County is hereby directed to credit the District Health Fund of Cuyahoga County the sum of Thirty Four Thousand Three Hundred Eighty One Dollars (\$34,381.00), and to deduct from regular tax settlements to be made for the City of Highland Heights during the year 2018, two (2) semi-annual installments of Seventeen Thousand One Hundred Ninety Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$17,190.50) each.

Section 3 The Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Cuyahoga County Auditor immediately upon its passage.

Section 4 That the Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5 This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Highland Heights for the reason that the subject contract must be executed in order to provide continuing public health services within the City of Highland Heights, Ohio. It shall therefore take place immediately upon passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approval by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.





CONTRACT FOR PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICES
(City with a General Health District - Authority--Sec.3709.08 O.R.C.)

WHEREAS, the District Advisory Council of the Cuyahoga County, Ohio, General Health District, at a meeting held March 15, 2017, by a majority vote of members representing the townships and villages did vote affirmatively on the question of providing public health services to the **City of Highland Heights**, Ohio, and did authorize the Chairman of the District Advisory Council to enter into a contract with the Mayor of **Highland Heights**, Ohio, for providing public health services therein; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the **City of Highland Heights**, at a Council meeting held November 14, 2017, by majority vote of all members did vote affirmatively on the question of contracting with the District Advisory Council of the Cuyahoga County General Health District for providing public health services to the **City of Highland Heights** and did authorize the Mayor to enter into a contract with the Chairman of the District Advisory Council of the Cuyahoga County General Health District to provide public health services.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to such authority, David Smith on behalf of the District Advisory Council of the Cuyahoga County General Health District and Scott E. Coleman on behalf of the **City of Highland Heights** do agree as follows:


The General Health District of Cuyahoga County, Ohio, hereby agrees to provide health services for the **City of Highland Heights** for the year 2018. These health services will be provided by the District Board of Health of Cuyahoga County and will include all necessary medical, nursing, sanitary, laboratory and such other health services as are required by the Statutes of the State of Ohio. Air pollution enforcement services, as described in Chapter 3704 of the Ohio Revised Code, will be conducted through the designated agent, the Cleveland Division of Air Pollution Control. This authorization is contingent upon renewal of the contract between the Ohio EPA and the City of Cleveland and satisfactory performance of the contract terms and conditions regarding air pollution control in Cuyahoga County. The Board of Health reserves the right to alter, modify or amend this contract provision with notice to the City.

The **City of Highland Heights** hereby agrees, in return for the health services which will be provided by the District Board of Health of Cuyahoga County for the year 2018, to pay to the Cuyahoga County General Health District the sum of Thirty Four Thousand Three Hundred Eighty One Dollars (\$34,381.00). This sum of Thirty Four Thousand Three Hundred Eighty One Dollars (\$34,381.00) the **City of Highland Heights** hereby directs the Fiscal Officer of Cuyahoga County to place to the credit of the District Health Fund of Cuyahoga County, and the Fiscal Office of Cuyahoga County is hereby authorized to deduct said sum of Thirty Four Thousand Three Hundred Eighty One Dollars (\$34,381.00) in equal semi-annual installments of Seventeen Thousand One Hundred Ninety Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$17,190.50) from the regular tax settlement to be made for said city for the year 2018. This contract shall be in full force and effect from January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018.
