



5. First Reading of Proposed Resolution authorizing the Mayor to execute a contract with Montrose Ford for the purchase of two (2) 2023 Ford Explorer Police Interceptors, pursuant to the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Act in an amount not to exceed Eighty-Two Thousand Nine Hundred and Eleven Dollars (\$82,911.00) and declaring an emergency.
