AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE RECREATION DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, OHIO FOR 2017, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT HEREWITH AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, OHIO, THAT:

Section 1: The compensation of the employees of the Recreation Department of the City of Highland Heights, Ohio for 2017 shall be as follows:



Section 2: That the Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirement of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Highland Heights for the reason that it provides compensation for employees of the municipality that are necessary for its day-to-day operation. It shall therefore take effect immediately upon passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approval by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.




